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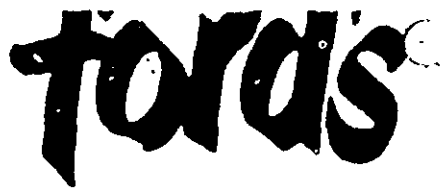
3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. STORAGE: Store product in original container in a cool, dry, locked place out of reach of children. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. CONTAINER DISPOSAL: BAGS-Completely empty bag into application equipment. ROACH and CRICKET BAIT is ready to use and is effective for the control of crickets and the cockroaches listed below. It gives rapid kill of these insects, including those resistant to certain chlorinated hydrocarbon and phosphate insecticides. Crickets and roaches die quickly after feeding on this bait.

COCKROACHES: American, Brown, Brown Banded, German & Oriental.

CRICKETS: Field and Mole Crickets.

FOR USE IN AND AROUND HOMES, APARTMENT BUILDINGS, STORES, RESTAURANTS, (non-food areas) AND WAREHOUSES: Apply bait lightly to floors near baseboards, in closets, under sinks and refrigerators, around and inside garbage cans and in other areas where insects are found, but which are inaccessible to children, such as cracks and crevices. Do not apply to animals. Do not treat portions of buildings where animals can feed on bait. Use approximately 4 ounces of bait per 1,000 sq. ft. of space and scatter lightly so that the bait is barely visible. Repeat as necessary. Keep out of reach of children.

FOR USE BY PEST CONTROL OPERATORS IN RESTAURANTS (food areas), Poultry Packing, Red Meat Packing and Food Processing Plants: Apply bait on paper, pasteboard or other material that will permit removal. Locate these bait stations on window sills, on floor near walls, in storage areas, and other areas where insects have been observed. Maintain strict account of location and number of bait stations. Do not apply bait in edible product areas until operations have ceased for the day. Remove all bait stations from the edible products areas before resuming operations.

FOR OUTDOOR USE AROUND FLOWER GARDENS, PATIOS, DRIVEWAYS, SIDEWALKS AND FOUNDATIONS: apply bait evenly in a 2 to 3 foot wide band at the rate of 4 ounces/1,000 Sq.Ft. around foundations, patios, driveways or sidewalks taking care to treat any cracks or crevices. For maximum effectiveness treat beneath concrete drain splashpans. For application in or around flower gardens, scatter bait at the rate of 4 ounces/1,000 Sq.Ft. as a broadcast, or apply a protective barrier around the garden as a 1 foot wide band.
