HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

A PARTIAL LIST OF WEEDS CONTROLLED - BLACK MEDIC, CANADA THISTLE, CHICKWEED, CLOVER, CURLY DOCK, DANDELION, ENGLISH DAISY, FLEABAN, FLORIDA PUSLEY, GROUND IVY, HEAL-ALL, HENBIT, KNOTWEED, LAMBSQUARTER, MUSTARD, PENNYWORT, MORNING GLORY, PIGWEED, PLANTAIN, POISON IVY, POISON OAK, PRICKLY LETTUCE, PURSLANE, SHEEP SORREL, SPOTTED SPURGE, THISTLE, WILD ONION. (This product will not kill "Grassy Weeds". Use Liquid Edger EPA Reg. No. 10370-146.)

Formulated for Spot application to individual weeds. This Spot Weeder produces a foamy white lather for direct weed contact which avoids drift and marks the weeds as they are treated.

1. Shake can just before using and occasionally during use.
2. Invert can, hold at arms length, and point nozzle at weed as you press... button. Do not press button when can is in upright position since gas will escape and product cannot be expelled.
3. Stand close to weed (1 to 2 feet) with can aimed at weed and away from face.
4. Push down briefly on button. Spray to cover center of weed. Do not over-spray. The spray's foaming action will make it easy for you to see coverage.
5. One application will kill most weeds listed. If certain tough weeds are not dead within 2 weeks, repeat application.
