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FLIES, FUNGUS GNATS and CECID FLIES in growing houses, apply at a rate of 1 ounce per 1,000 cubic feet of space. Fogger should be operated 8 to 10 feet away from beds and directed slightly upward over them. Circulating fans should be left in operation, but for best results refrigeration should be turned off. In packing and canning plants, use at a rate of 1 ounce to 2,000 cubic feet of space.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **PESTICIDE STORAGE AND SPILL PROCEDURES:** Store upright at room temperature. Avoid exposure to extreme temperatures. In case of spill or leakage, soak up with an absorbent material such as sand, sawdust, earth, fuller's earth, etc. Dispose of with chemical waste.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide, spray mixture or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of at or by an approved waste disposal facility.
