

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDOUS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

DANGER: Corrosive, may cause severe skin and eye irritation or chemical burns to broken skin. Causes eye damage. Wear safety glasses or goggles and rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash after handling. Avoid breathing vapors. Vacate poorly ventilated areas as soon as possible. Do not return until strong odors have dissipated.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT: Mix only with water according to label directions. Mixing this product with chemicals (e.g. ammonia, acids, detergents, etc.) or organic matter (e.g. urine, feces, etc.) will release chlorine gas which is irritating to eyes, lungs and mucous membranes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

NOTE: This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit and increase dosage, as necessary, to obtain the required level of available chlorine.

PURPOSE	AMOUNT TO USE	DIRECTIONS
LAUNDERING: For washing machines, automatic washers or tub. Bleach, bleaches and sanitizes fast colors or white cottons and linens, also nylon dresden and other or any mixture of these fabrics with cotton or linen. (WILL NOT HARM SEPTIC TANK OR MACHINE)	1 oz or 1/8 cup of Bleach to each 2 gallons of water, or 1 cup per washing machine load (18 gallons). For slightly soiled clothes use proportionately less Bleach.	Add Bleach to suds or first rinse. Rinse well. Bleach cannot be added before clothes are in machine, dilute recommended amount in one quart of water before using.
TO WRITEN YELLOWED OR GREYED NYLON, DACRON, OR ORLON.	Use 2 tablespoons or 1/8 cup Bleach to one gallon fairly warm water.	Immerse clean fabric 15 to 30 minutes in Bleach solution. Rinse well. Repeat if needed.
REMOVE SCORCH & STAINS: Such as fruit, ink, berry wine, coffee, tea, chocolate, grease, etc. also mildew.	One part Bleach to 20 parts water, or 1/4 cup Bleach per quart of water.	Soak fabric 5 to 10 minutes in Bleach solution. Rinse well.
CLEANING KITCHEN & BATHROOM: Bleach is excellent for cleaning tile, porcelain, enamelware, bathtubs & linoleum.	2 tablespoons or 1/8 cup Bleach in quart of cold water.	Spread with cloth moistened with cold water. Let stand 2 minutes. Rinse well.
SANITIZING HAND FOOD-CONTACT SURFACES: In Restaurants, Taverns, Soda fountains, Dairies.	1 oz. or 1/8 cup of Bleach per 2 gallons of water.	This is recommended standard sanitizing solution by many Public Health Departments. MAKE SOLUTION 200 P.P.M. AVAILABLE CHLORINE. Clean surface. Rinse surface with potable water prior to treatment with the sanitizing solution. Rinse thoroughly with sanitizing solution for two minutes. Let or dry.
GENERAL DISINFECTING USES: Dishcloths, handkerchiefs, diapers, baby clothes, etc.	3 Tablespoons of Bleach to each quart of cold or lukewarm water.	First wash in clear water. Immerse in Bleach solution 5 minutes. Rinse well.
SICK ROOM, URINALS, BEDPANS, SPUTUM, CUPS ETC. To clean and deodorize.	3 tablespoons of Bleach per quart of hot water.	Wash clean. Place in Bleach solution 5 minutes. Rinse dry.
TOILET BOWLS DRAIN PIPES: To clean.	Full strength. For stains: 1/2 cup in toilet bowl and a few drops of vinegar or lemon will remove stains.	Will not harm plumbing or septic tanks. Do not use with other household chemicals. Flush with boiling water.

CAUTION: DO NOT USE BLEACH WITH AMMONIA OR TOILET BOWL CLEANERS. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT IN COOL PLACE TIGHTLY CAPPED.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store this product in a cool dry area, away from direct sunlight and heat to avoid deterioration. In case of spill, flood areas with large quantities of water. Product or rinsate that cannot be used should be diluted with water before disposal in a sanitary sewer. Do not reuse container but place in trash collection. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
