Dear Mr. Formica:

The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is accepted with conditions.

Conditions

1. Add the following statement to the First Aid section of the label: Have the product container or label with you when calling a Poison Control Center or doctor or going in for treatment.
2. Correct the Sanitizing directions for use heading to read "SANITIZING HARD **NON-POROUS** FOOD CONTACT SURFACES."
3. The broad term "etc." should be removed from the "GENERAL DISINFECTING USES" section of the label.
4. Correct the following typographical errors under the use directions:
 - (a) Change **ar** to **are** under the Laundering section.
 - (b) Change **minu tes** to **minutes** under the General Disinfecting section.

General Comments

A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with comments is enclosed. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

FIRST AID

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Contact poison control center or doctor for further advice.

If swallowed: Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin: Remove contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for further advice or treatment.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDOUS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

DANGER: Corrosive may cause severe skin and eye irritation or chemical burns to broken skin. Causes eye damage. Wear safety glasses or goggles and rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash after handling. Avoid breathing vapors. Vacate poorly ventilated areas as soon as possible. Do not return until strong odors have dissipated.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:

This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT: Mix only with water according to label directions. Never mix this product with other chemicals such as toilet bowl cleaners, acids, detergents, organic matter or products containing ammonia or vinegar. To do so will release chlorine gas, which is irritating to eyes, lungs, and mucous membrane, and in some cases can be fatal.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
NOTE: This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test kit and increase dosage, as necessary, if obtain the required level of available chlorine.

PURPOSE

LAUNDERING: For washing machines, automatic washers or tub. Bleach, bleaches and sanitizes fast colors or white cottons and linens, also nylon dacron and orlon or any mixture of these fabrics with cotton or linen. (WILL NOT HARM SEPTIC TANK OR MACHINE)

TO WHITEN YELLOWED OR GRAYED NYLON, DACRON, OR ORLON.

REMOVE SCORCH & STAINS: Such as fruit, ink, berry wine, coffee, tea, chocolate, grease, etc. also mildew.

CLEANING KITCHEN BATHROOM: Bleach is excellent for cleaning tile, porcelain, enamelware, bathtubs & Enzium.

SANITIZING HARD-FOOD-CONTACT SURFACES: In Restaurants, Taverns, Soda fountains, Dairies, Food Processing Plants.

GENERAL DISINFECTING USES: Dishcloths, handkerchiefs, diapers, baby clothes,

SICK ROOM, URINALS, BEDPANS, SPUTUM, CUPS ETC: To clean and deodorize.

TOILET BOWLS DRAIN PIPES: to clean.

ADDITIONAL CAUTIONS: Do not use on copper, aluminum, iron, silverware, antique porcelain or other metal objects.

**This product is not to be used as a terminal sterilant/high level disinfectant on any surface or instrument that (1) is introduced directly into human body, either into or in contact with the bloodstream or normally sterile areas of the body, or (2) contacts intact mucous membranes but which does not ordinarily penetrate the blood barrier or otherwise enter normally sterile areas of the body. This product may be used to pre-clean or decontaminate critical or semi-critical devices prior to sterilization of high-level disinfection.*

AMOUNT TO USE

1 oz. of 1/8 cup of Bleach to each 2 gallons of water, or 1 cup per washing machine load (16 gallons). For slightly soiled clothes use proportionately less Bleach.

Use 2 tablespoons or 1/8 cup Bleach to one gallon fairly warm water.

One part Bleach to 20 parts water, or 1/4 cup Bleach per quart of water.

2 tablespoons or 1/8 cup Bleach in quart of cold water.

1 oz. or 1/8 cup of Bleach per 2 gallons of water.

3 tablespoons of Bleach to each quart of cold or lukewarm water.

3 tablespoons of Bleach per quart of hot water.

Full strength. For stains 1/2 cup in toilet bowl and a few drops of vinegar or lemon will remove stains.

KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT IN COOL PLACE TIGHTLY CAPPED.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store this product in a cool dry area away from direct sunlight and heat to avoid deterioration. In case of spill, flood areas with large quantities of water. Unused product or diluted solutions that can not be used should be diluted with water before disposal in a sanitary sewer. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal or use of product. If empty do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled, call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

DIRECTIONS

Add Bleach to suds or first rinse. Rinse well. Bleach cannot be added before clothes are in machine, dilute recommended amount in one quart of water before using.

Immerse clean fabric 15 to 30 minutes in Bleach solution. Rinse well. Repeat if needed.

Rinse to remove loose soil. Soak fabric 5 to 10 minutes in Bleach solution. Rinse well. Repeat if needed.

Spread with cloth moistened with cold water. Let stand 2 minutes. Rinse well.

This is recommended standard sanitizing solution by many Public Health Departments. **SAME SOLUTION 260 P.P.M. AVAILABLE CHLORINE.** Clean surface. Rinse surfaces with potable water prior to treatment with the sanitizing solution. Rinse thoroughly with sanitizing solution for two minutes. Let air dry.

First wash in clear water. Immerse in Bleach solution 5 minutes. Rinse well.

Wash clean. Place in Bleach solution 5 minutes. Rinse and dry. A fresh Bleach solution should be prepared for each day's use. If the Bleach solution does not become diluted or soiled, the solution may be re-used for the day's needs.

Will not harm plumbing or septic tanks. Do not use with other household chemicals. Flush with boiling water.
