WECO WEED KILLER 113 is a specially formulated nonselective vegetation killer. Dilute on the basis of 3 gallons of water for each gallon of WECO 113 before spraying. WECO 113 has no harmful residual activity in soil at recommended rates. It is an aqueous contact weed killer specially prepared for municipal and industrial weed control.

**DESCRIPTION OF PRODUCT:**

WECO WEED KILLER 113 is a nonvolatile, nonexplosive, nonflammable aqueous formulation. It is essentially noncorrosive. It exhibits a very rapid action on aerial parts of plants. Under sunny-warm conditions the first symptoms can be observed within one to two hours, severe wilting after 24 hours.

**RECOMMENDATIONS FOR USE:**

For treating 100 sq. ft. dilute one pint of WECO 113 in 3 pints of water. For 1000 sq. ft. dilute 5 qts. of WECO 113 in 15 qts. of water for a total volume of 5 gallons. For one acre dilute 50 gals. of WECO 113 in 150 gals. of water for a total volume of 200 gallons. Spraying until vegetation is thoroughly wet is important for best results. Application may be made at any time during the growing season. Early application produces better results. Repeat applications should be made to control some perennials and late germinating annual weeds. Apply WECO 113 as a directed spray for the control of weeds at the base of trees, shrubs, vines, hedge plants. Avoid spray contact of the foliage of desirable plants. Use hand sprinkler, hand sprayer or machine sprayer.

**DO NOT APPLY:** Do not allow spray to contact foliage or stems of desirable plants. Do not allow spray to contact desirable lawn grasses.

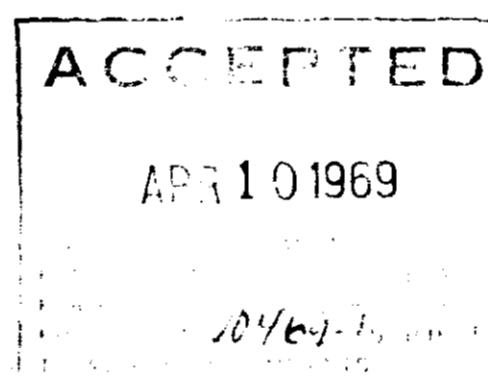
