DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**DISEASE CONTROL
IN TURFGRASS**

Do not rotate crop with crops other than Thiram uses. LESCO Thiram 75W is a Preventative and Curative turf fungicide. Dollar Spot and Typhula-Snow Mold.

DISEASE PREVENTIVE USE

For Brown Patch and Dollar Spot - Use 75W per 1,000 sq. ft. at 7 days intervals. September. For Snow Mold - when use snow, use 8 ounces per 1,000 sq. ft. For use 3 ounces per 1,000 sq. ft. as soon as possible.

TURF DISEASE CURATIVE USE

For Brown Patch and Dollar Spot - use sq. ft.. Begin application when disease is at 7 to 10 days intervals as necessary to complete coverage of area to be treated with 5 to 10 gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft. or hose/proportioners using agitation. Thiram 75W is insoluble in water and is agitated. Constant agitation is necessary in suspension. Do not cut or water grass until the fungicide is thoroughly dry.

**FOR USE AS
ANIMAL REPELLENT**

Use Thiram 75W to place a protective repellent on plants and deer from feeding on plant tissue. Repellency results from Thiram treated plant parts. It may be used on plantings, or to other established nurseries and nut trees, fruit bushes and vines, or nursery stock in late summer or early fall to prevent animal damage or when animal damage is severe. Use treated plants for food or feed purposes.

SPRAY APPLICATION; GROUND

Prepare a slurry of 1 pound of Thiram 75W (continuous agitation of spray solution) as a heavy full coverage spray to all portions protected. For greater retention and residual efficacy blend 1 pint of latex based sticker to the spray, wetting agents or surfactants as recommended. Apply under favorable drying conditions above 40° F and relative humidity is less than 70%.

SPRAY APPLICATION, TRUNKS AND DORMANT PLANTS

Prepare a slurry of 1 pound of Thiram 75W and apply as spray to all portions of the trunk and branches up to a height of 6 feet. For retention and residual efficacy use 1 pint of latex based sticker to the spray solution.

BRUSH ON APPLICATION

Prepare a slurry of 1 pound of Thiram 75W and apply with a paint brush to protect trunks up to a height of 2 1/2 feet. For retention and residual efficacy blend 1 fluid ounce of latex based sticker to each quart volume of solution prepared.

FOR DORMANT PLANTS

Mix 8 lbs. + 1 gal. Latex Sticker in 100 g pressure sprayer with agitation. Through 5 feet (above animal reach) as a twig spray. This application will also protect sumac from nibbling. Higher rates may be needed for heavy deer pressure.
