### LAWN INSECTS

**Lawn Chinch Bugs:** Apply 1/2-1 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. (2 1/2-5 lbs. per 5,000 sq. ft.). Water lawn thoroughly after application. Repeat application in 7-10 days if necessary. For longer residual control and on dense growing turf such as St. Augustine grass, use 1-1 1/2 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. (5-7 1/2 lbs. per 5,000 sq. ft.).

**Billbugs; White Grubs such as Japanese Beetle Larva, European Chafer, and Southern Chafer:** Apply 1 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. of lawn. Water grass thoroughly after application. For grub control make application any time between late July and early October. For billbug control apply when activity is first observed or when chewed or brown grass is present, indicating damage from this insect.

**Hyperodes Weevil (New York only):** Apply 3/4 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. of grass. Water grass thoroughly after application. Treat problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

#### Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals
