DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HOW TO USE

To control chinch bugs, sod webworms, ants, armyworms, crickets, cut worms, earwigs, and sowbugs, uniformly apply one (1) pound of this product to cover 1,000 square feet of non-crop turfgrass area. Treat when insects first appear; re-treat as needed. To help obtain uniform distribution, apply one-half the required amount of product in one direction; then apply balance at a right angle. Immediately after application, thoroughly water the treated turf to wash the insecticide into the zone of insect infestation.

To control certain white grubs (larvae of European chafer and Japanese beetle), use 4 pounds of this product per 1,000 square feet. Apply the granules uniformly over the area treated followed immediately by thorough watering to wash insecticide into turf. For best results, treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near soil surface, usually during late July and August. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for proper time to treat in your area.
