STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instruction must be disposed of according to applicable federal, state or local procedures.

Container Disposal: Completely empty bag by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of bags in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities.

For use on St. Augustine and Centipede lawns. Do not use on Bluegrass, Fescue, Bent, Bahia, Rye, Bermuda or Dicondra lawn. Post emergent broadleaf control of such weeds as: Chickweed, Creeping Charlie, Dandelion, Evening Primrose, Florida Betony, Florida Pusley, Lippia, Oxalis, Pigweed, Pennywort, Plantain, Rat bit Tobacco and Toadflax. Pre-emergent control of: Crabgrass, Paspalums, Sedge and Spotted Spurge.

WHEN TO APPLY: For broadleaf post emergence control apply anytime the weeds are present and actively growing. (Spring application is recommended for best control.) For pre-emergence control apply before the Crabgrass, Paspalums, Sedge and Spotted Spurge germinate. The precise time of application for a specific area will vary. Consult state agricultural experiment station weed specialist or local turf authorities for any additional information regarding specific weed germination dates in your area.

HOW TO APPLY: Apply 4.5 to 6.0 pounds of Lesco Fertilizer + Atrazine uniformly over one thousand square feet of lawn area (equivalent to 1.5 to 2.0 lbs. Atrazine per acre). This will provide 1 to 1½ pounds of actual nitrogen per thousand square feet. Watering of treated area immediately after application is recommended to wash pellets off the grass blades.

CAUTION: Avoid application under the drip line of trees, shrubs and ornamentals to prevent injury to plants. Lesco Fertilizer + Atrazine should not be applied to newly seeded Centipede until the new grass has been mowed at least once. Delay sprig planting one month and seeding 6 months after application.
