PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Metal. Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling or reconditioning or dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved State and local procedures.

Plastic. Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling or reconditioning or dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if permitted by State and local authorities.

IMPORTANT

Avoid drift of spray or coarse sprays are less likely to drift onto vegetables, flowers, ornamental shrubs, trees and other desirable crop plants.

USE & APPLICATION: LESCO THREE-WAY

Use LESCO Three-Way Selective Herbicide on lawns, turf (not pastures) and golf fairways, aprons, tees and roughs at the rate of 1.2 to 1.5 ounces per 1000 square feet (3 to 4 pints per acre) in sufficient water (1 to 5 gallons per 1000 square feet) to insure adequate coverage.

Apply as a foliar spray when weeds are young and actively growing. It may be necessary to make a second application (spring and fall) to kill certain hard-to-kill weeds such as poison ivy, poison oak and English daisy. Weeds that start growing in the fall, such as henbit, may be controlled more effectively with a fall application.

LESCO Three Way is not recommended for closely mowed Bentgrass such as golf and bowling greens.

c. Revise the container disposal statements to read:

1. Metal - Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
2. Plastic - Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

d. On the left panel, delete "DANGER" above "Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals" and replace with the general heading "Precautionary Statements."
