Your Submission Dated November 3, 1987**

The amendments referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, are acceptable provided that you make the labeling change listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- Delete the term "For Professional Use Only." This term is too broad and cannot be enforced.

Child-resistant packaging rules apply for the 1 gallon container size. See the *Federal Register* Notice dated June 11, 1986, 21276.

Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed.

The additional brand name LESCO Bentgrass Selective Broadleaf Herbicide is being accepted under this registration as shown on the stamped copy.

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PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

DANGER. Corrosive, causes eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. May be fatal if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE

Do not store in direct contact with fertilizer, seeds, insecticides, or fungicides. Keep from freezing.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your state Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Metal - Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities.

Plastic - Triple rinse (or equivalent) then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or by other procedures approved by State and local authorities, by burning if burned, stay out of smoke.

IMPORTANT

A good rain or deep watering should occur during this period. Do not apply to areas underlain by roots of desirable trees and shrubs.
