
The labeling cited above and submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, successfully **REMOVES THE PRODUCT FROM THE SCOPE** of PR Notice 93-7 once the comments (if any) on the attached sheet are addressed. Other than the alterations (if any) listed on the attached sheet, no further alterations to the labeling are necessary to reflect the requirements of the Worker Protection Standard.

Since your amendment proposes to delete uses directly and/or to delete uses implicitly through the use of exclusionary statements, the Agency will publish in the Federal Register a notice of receipt of your amendment to delete uses, as required by section 6(f)(1) of FIFRA. The Agency will defer action for 90 days from the date of the Federal Register notice to give affected minor users an opportunity to try to persuade you to retain the uses(s). When the comment period has expired, the Agency will approve the amendment unless you have withdrawn it, and stamp the amended labeling "accepted." Your stamped-accepted labeling will then be sent to you.

As described in Supplement A of PR Notice 93-11 (self-verification option), you may sell and distribute product bearing the submitted labeling before you receive a copy of your stamped-accepted labeling. Note that your registration is not amended until the comment period required by section 6(f)(1) of FIFRA has expired and the Agency has approved the amendment. Therefore, you may withdraw your proposed amendment at any time during the comment period and until you receive your stamped-accepted labeling.

MIXING AND APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Add LESCO PRE-M 60 DG slowly to partially filled tank (2 to 3 1/2 gal) of water. Do not spray until the remainder of the tank with water. 2. CONTINUE MIXING AGITATION WHILE ADDING LESCO PRE-M 60 DG. The suspension is allowed to settle for any period of time, through which aeration will be given the mixture before spraying is resumed. Do not agitate while spraying as needed.

3. Do not spray on wet or recently watered turfgrass. 4. Do not spray on turfgrass if the temperature is below 50°F. 5. Do not spray on turfgrass if the wind is blowing unfavorably from target areas.

Treatments are most effective in controlling weeds when adequate rain fall or overhead irrigation is received within 7 days after application. Avoid contact of spray solution with driveways, stone, wood or other porous surfaces. Residue of a fairly slow drying.

COMPATIBILITY

LESCO PRE-M 60 DG is compatible with most commonly used fertilizers. When tank mixing be sure to add LESCO PRE-M 60 DG to the partially filled tank first, mix thoroughly, and then add combination products to the mixture in the directions or instructions on its EPA approved label. Do not apply tank mix combinations unless product is approved for such tank mix use and previous experience indicates the mixture is effective and will not result in application problems or phytotoxicity. Do not attempt to use LESCO PRE-M 60 DG directly with liquid fertilizers. Pre-mix one part of LESCO PRE-M 60 DG with two parts water and add the desired volume slowly into the tank while agitating.

GENERAL INFORMATION

LESCO PRE-M 60 DG treatments will not control established weeds. Apply as directed prior to germination of weed seeds. Three applications per year may be made, at least 2 months between applications except when otherwise indicated on this label.

Use only on well established turfgrass with a dense and uniform stand. Do not use on newly seeded or sprigged turfgrass. Do not use on winter overseeded turfgrass. Do not use on turfgrass severely stressed by winter stress.

LESCO PRE-M 60 DG provides effective residual weed control which may affect new turfgrass seedlings or sprigs. Do not reseed or winter overseed established turfgrass until 4 growing months after application. Do not spray turfgrass until 5 weeks after application. Do not use on Bermudagrass or Cynodora maintained as a separate turf.

WARNING: LESCO PRE-M 60 DG contains the active ingredients pendimethalin and 1,4-dimethyl-2,6-dinitrobenzamide which are listed in the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act.
