STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

HOW TO APPLY: Turf should be free of troub-
lesome thatch which encourages insects.
Rake or de-thatch the area and remove the
debris to expose insect hiding places. Water
the lawn and cut to proper height. Apply
granules as recommended and sprinkle the
area to move the insecticide down to the soil
surface where insects feed. Apply at the rate
of 2 1/2 lbs. per 1,000 sq.ft. of turf. This is
equivalent to 110 pounds per acre. See

May to June) or when your lawn program
calls for a Surface Insect Control Application.
Repeat as the program indicates or as
needed for control. Sod webworms may have
3 to 4 generation of larvae in 1 year which
may require additional treatments at 40 to 50
day intervals during the summer months.

OVERALL TREATMENT FOR GRUBS
(Equal to 165 lbs per acre.) Water granules
into turf after application using approximately
15 to 30 gallons per 1,000 Sq.Ft. Make appli-
cation any time between late July and Early
October or when brown dead grass areas indi-
cates damage from these root feeding in-
sects. Repeat as necessary.

AREA TREATMENT- Use a suitable lawn
spreader to apply to 3/4 lb./1,000 sq ft (33

**PERIMETER INSECT CONTROL TREAT-
MENT - (Around Buildings):** For treatment
around the outsides of Residential and
Commercial Buildings to control Ants, Crick-
ets, Cutworms and Armyworms treat a 4 to 6
foot wide band surrounding the building by
applying 1/2 to 1 pound granules per 1,000
Sq.Ft. of surface. Use an appropriate hand-
held Fertilizer Spreader or other suitable
spreading equipment or a shaker top con-
tainer to give even distribution of the gran-
ules. Do not apply with hand. Repeat as
needed for continued control. Lightly sprinkle
area to wash granules to soil surface.
