The Registration Division (RD) has conducted a review of this request for its applicability under PRN 98-10 and finds that the action requested falls within the scope of PRN 98-10.

The label submitted with the application has been stamped "NOTIFICATION" and placed in our records.

The alternate brand name, "LESCO FERTILIZER PLUS PRE-EMERGENT HERBICIDE DIMENSION™ 0.15% PLUS FERTILIZER" has been added to the product record.

This product is a premium quality combination product that provides both weed control and the required nutrients for optimum turfgrass growth all in a single product.

It contains Dimension herbicide that can be applied up to 4 weeks later than other crabgrass preventers, and provides up to 4 months control of crabgrass and other grasses and broadleaf weeds when applied prior to their germination in lawns and ornamental turfgrasses.

Apply to well-established lawns and ornamental turfgrasses listed below. (See "Use on the following Turfgrasses" section for a list of the tolerant turfgrasses). This product will not harm nearby established ornamentals when used according to directions given below.

USE PRECAUTIONS

This product should only be applied to lawns and ornamental turfgrasses that are well established. Use of this product on lawns and ornamental turfgrasses that are not well established, or have been weakened by stress due to mechanical operations, pests, excessive temperatures, or lack of moisture, may increase the chances for turfgrass injury. This product should be applied in the spring or fall prior to weed seed germination in established and newly germinated lawns and ornamental turfgrasses.

It can be applied up to 4 weeks later than other crabgrass preventers and still provide season-long weed control. This is due to the dithiopyr herbicide component of this combination product. This product provides preventative (pre-emergence) control of crabgrass and other weeds when applied prior to their germination, and post-emergence control of seedling seedling crabgrass. The post-emergence control provided by this product is limited to crabgrass only and will provide control of crabgrass when applied up to 4 weeks after crabgrass germination. Application of this product later than 4 weeks after crabgrass germination will result in reduced control of crabgrass.

For control of other grass and broadleaf weeds, this product must be applied as a preventative treatment before their germination. crabgrass will be controlled with delayed applications after germination.

Tips for Improved Weed Control: For best results, apply this product within a few days after mowing and delay further mowings after the application until the lawn or ornamental turfgrass has been watered or received significant rainfall to dissolve the fertilizer granules. Improved weed control may be observed when treated lawn or ornamental turfgrass is watered or receives rainfall within a few days after application of this product.

RESEEDING, OVERSEEDING OR SPRIGGING

Reseeding, overseeding or sprigging of treated areas with this product should be delayed until 12 weeks from the time of application. Reseeding, overseeding or sprigging before 12 weeks after application may prevent establishment of desirable turfgrasses. When reseeding or overseeding, proper cultural practice such as soil cultivation, irrigation and fertilization should be followed. However, if overseeding with perennial ryegrass in the fall, overseed 8 weeks or later after a single application.

For best results, use mechanical or power seeding equipment (slit seeders) designed to give good seed to soil contact.

To establish a new lawn of Kentucky Bluegrass, Perennial Ryegrass and/or Tall Fescue, this product may be applied 2 weeks after the first sign of germination. For other tolerant turfgrasses listed on this label, wait until the grass is well established (2 mowings) before applying this product.

WHEN TO APPLY - APPLICATION TIMINGS

This product may be applied either in the spring or in the fall for the control of weeds. When this product is applied in the fall, a sequential or second application should be made the following spring to provide season-long control of weeds.

If this product is applied in the fall, DO NOT reseed, overseed, or sprig turfgrasses before 8 weeks after application of this product due to potential turfgrass injury to the newly reseeded, overseeded, or sprigged turfgrasses.

When establishing a new lawn of Kentucky Bluegrass, Perennial Ryegrass, and/or Tall Fescue, this product should not be applied prior to 8 weeks before seeding, but may be applied two weeks to 8 weeks after the first sign of grass germination.

LENGTH OF WEED CONTROL

This product may provide up to 4 months of weed control if applied according to label directions. The actual length of control will vary depending on use rate, weather conditions, condition of the turfgrass, intensity of weed pressure, and the location or "Region" within the United States where this product is being applied. POST-EMERGENCE CRABGRASS CONTROL

This product can be applied with a rotary or drop type spreader designed to apply granular fertilizers. For best results, apply the product evenly and uniformly over the turfgrass area, avoiding streaking, skips, or overlaps. Avoid the use of spreaders that would apply this product in narrow rows or concentrated bands. Before each application, calibrate the spreader according to the equipment manufacturer's directions. Adjust the spreader settings such that the spreader delivers the appropriate application rates of this product as recommended below.

A more uniform application can be made by spreading one-half of the recommended amount of this product over the turfgrass area and then applying the remaining one-half of this product at a right angle to the previous application direction. Check application equipment frequently to ensure equipment is functioning properly and applying a uniform distribution of product.
