Atrazine can travel (seep or leach) through soil and can enter ground water which may be used as drinking water. Atrazine has been found in ground water. Users are advised not to apply Atrazine on sand and loamy sand soils where the water table (ground water) is close to the surface and where these soils are very permeable; i.e., well-drained. Your local agricultural agencies can provide further information on the type of soil in your area and the location of ground water.

Product must not be mixed or loaded within 50 feet of intermittent streams and rivers, natural or impounded lakes and reservoirs. ## NON-AGRICULTURAL REQUIREMENTS

The requirements in this box apply to uses of this product that are NOT within the scope of the Worker Protection Standard for agricultural pesticides (40 CFR Part 170). #### WHEN TO APPLY

Best weed control will result if applied before weeds sprout since the product acts as a "pre-emergent" and also as a "post-emergent" herbicide. Established weeds are harder to kill and may require an additional application in the fall or spring. For newly seeded centipede, wait until grass has been mowed at least once. Do not plant "sprigs" within one month after application, or seed within 6 months after application. For broadleaf weeds apply anytime the weeds are present and actively growing. Early spring application is recommended for best control such as January 1st up to March 1st, otherwise it may be applied up to June 15th with good weed

For pre-emergence weed control (see above) apply before seeds germinate. application will be needed for control of certain annuals such as Chickweed. Henbit application will be needed for control of certain annuals such as Chickweed, rhenbit, Rabbit Tobacco, Florida Betony and Evening Primrose. In case of heavy weed infestation or low soil moisture, a repeat application may be necessary. Wait 2 months for a repeat application. Apply when air is calm to prevent particle wind drift. Apply this product only when grass blades are dry. To verify proper application timing consult your State Agricultural Extension Service, Turfgrass Specialist.

Sweep product off walks and painted surfaces following application to avoid possible discolorations.
