

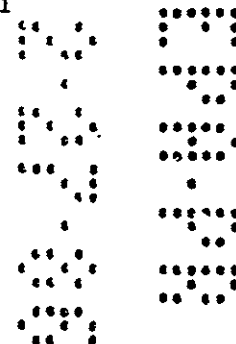

Add one part of Dura-Treet II to six parts of water or to the desired concentration and mix well. Treat wood members as otherwise described below. Pressure treatment in a commercial pressure facility allows for the attainment of proper retention and penetration levels and makes the treated wood products suitable for ground contact.

To protect dry and/or seasoned lumber, timbers, posts, poles and other wooden members before construction or before placing in contact with the soil. The wood should be treated in a commercial vessel capable of physically (by pressure, temperature or time) impregnating the wood and providing adequate penetration and retention.
