

Workmen handling this product or treated material should wear impervious gloves, goggles or face shield, and protective clothing. All protective clothing, work shoes or boots, and equipment must be left at the work site at the end of the day. Eating, drinking, or smoking during use of this product is prohibited.

FIRST AID: *In case of skin contact*, wash promptly and thoroughly with soap and water and finally with glycerin. *If product gets in the eyes*, flush immediately with copious amounts of clean, cool water for 15 to 30 minutes. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

PAPER MILLS: To control bacterial and fungal growth on paper machines, Metasol TBT-102 is added to the water supply at 1 lb/ton of dry paper or paperboard produced.

COOLING TOWERS: Metasol TBT-102 is used to control bacterial growth against soft or surface rot and internal or dry rot in cooling towers. It is a dispersion containing 0.5 to 0.7% by weight of active ingredient in the clean wood surfaces. The amount applied is 1 lb of Metasol TBT-102 per 1000 ft.² of wood surface. It is inhibited by periodic shock doses of Metasol TBT-102. The shock dose is 1 lb of Metasol TBT-102 per 1000 gal. of water, applied 4 to 6 hr. after treatment. The shock treatment should be repeated every 2 months.

COOLING WATER: Metasol TBT-102 is used to control bacterial growth in industrial recirculating cooling water systems. The system should be cleaned thoroughly to remove sludge, scale, and other deposits. System should be treated with Metasol TBT-102 water, and treated with an initial dose of 0.6 lb of Metasol TBT-102 per 1000 gal. water in the system. Subsequent treatments should be made every 1 to 5 days, depending on the severity of microbiological fouling.
