In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(C) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Using the technical grade active ingredient, conduct and submit the following environmental studies, within 12 months of the date of this registration:

- Guideline Series 161-1 Hydrolysis
- Guideline Series 72-1 Fish Acute LC50 (2 species)
- Guideline Series 72-2 Aquatic Invertebrate EC50

3. Make the following label changes:

- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 10445-115".
- b. Include the following statement immediately below the heading "Directions For Use": It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- c. Add the following heading immediately below the heading "Precautionary Statements":

Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals
Keep Out Of Reach of Children

- d. Revise your "Statement of Practical Treatment" section to read:

If Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Drink large quantities of water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

If In Eyes: Flood eyes with water for at least 15 minutes.

If On Skin: Wash thoroughly with soap and water.

- e. Include the following statement on your product labeling:

Limit residues of Poly (N,N-dimethyl diallyl ammonium chloride) in the finished potable water to no more than 50 ppm."

- f. Revise your Environmental Hazards statement to read:

Environmental Hazards


This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic invertebrates. Do not use in facilities discharging directly or indirectly to estuarine or marine environments. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

4. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
