**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**IMPORTANT:** Read the entire directions for use before using Clearwood MW1.

**APPLICATION**

Clearwood-MW1 may be applied by dip, or pressure treatment methods. Solution uptake and treatment conditions for each method should result in a 250-2500 ppm retention of active ingredient in the treated article. Treated wood should be used only for above ground uses.

For pressure treatment, follow the general requirements of American Wood Preservers' Association Standard C-1. For dip treatment, immerse wood completely until enough solution has been absorbed to meet the retention requirements given above. Use dip treatment procedures consistent with the equipment being used and standard treatment practices.

Clearwood-MW1 can be tank-mixed with other pesticide products labeled for wood treatment. Read and follow the label of each tank mix product used for precautionary statements, directions for use, application rates, and other restrictions.

**STORAGE & DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**Pesticide Storage:** Store in a cool, dry place.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law.
