DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

IMPORTANT: Read the entire directions for use before using ClearWood-MW2.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (P.P.E.)

Applicators and other handlers must wear the following personal protective equipment:

- Coveralls over long sleeved shirt and long pants.
- Socks and chemical resistant footwear.
- Goggles or face shield
- Chemical resistant gloves such as barrier laminate, butyl rubber, nitrile rubber, neoprene rubber, PVC or viton.

APPLICATION

ClearWood-MW2 may be applied by dip, or pressure treatment methods. Solution uptake and treatment conditions for each method should result in a 250-2500 ppm combined retention of active ingredients in the treated article. Treated wood should be used only for above ground uses.

For pressure treatment, follow the general requirements of American Wood Preservers' Association Standards U1, T1. For dip treatment, immerse wood completely until enough solution has been absorbed to meet the retention requirements given above. Use dip treatment procedures consistent with the equipment being used and standard treatment practices.

ClearWood-MW2 can be tank-mixed with other pesticide products labeled for wood treatment. Read and follow the label of each tank mix product used for precautionary statements, directions for use, application rates, and other restrictions.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry place.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the hazardous waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

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
