### ACTIVE INGREDIENTS

bis (tri-n-butyltin) oxide . . . . . 0.70%  
dialkyl\* dimethyl ammonium chloride . . . . . 1.25%  
\*(alkyl group derived from coconut oil fatty acid) . . . . .  
5-chloro-2,2,4-dichlorophenoxy) phenol . . . . . 0.80%

INERT INGREDIENTS . . . . . 97.25%

## CAUTION

### KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

This is a concentrate which would be harmful if swallowed. May be absorbed through the skin. Causes skin irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. In case of contact, remove contaminated clothing; wash skin with soap and water; flush eyes with clear water for 15 minutes and get medical attention. Launder contaminated clothing before re-use.

Do not reuse empty drum. Return to drum reconditioner or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place.

For manufacturing use in rendering textiles resistant to the growth of bacteria. It inhibits the development of body odors on treated fabrics. Steri-Septic's bacteriostatic activity will last through at least 50 conventional launderings when applied in accordance with the accompanying directions.
