Conditions

1. Submission of all revised Product Information sheets as required by July 15, 1999 letter. You must also submit your latest technical data sheet.
2. Addition of the phrase "Total.....100%" lined up under the list of Ingredients on the proposed revised label.


General Comments

The revised product information sheets must be submitted within 30 days of your receipt of this letter. If this condition is not met then the Agency may pursue appropriate regulatory action to ensure your compliance with our statutory goals.

A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with conditions is enclosed. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.
