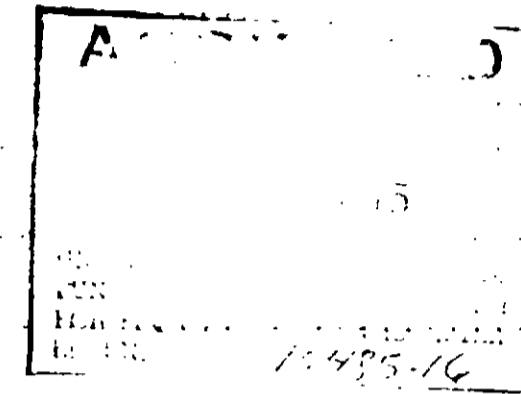

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS

Sodium Dimethylallylthiourea 9.75
 Naben (Disodium Ethylenebis(4-Nonylphenyl)oxides) 9.75

APPLICATIONS

ALPHA 550 is designed to control algae and bacteria for use in controlling the growth of bacteria and fungi in industrial recirculating water cooling towers. Begin treatment when the system is in jeopardy of becoming affected or after cleaning systems whose efficiency is already impaired. Initially apply ALPHA 550 at the rate of 21.2 ounces of product per each 1000 gallons of water in the system. This dose should be repeated once, twice or three times weekly or as required to control the growth of slime-forming organisms. When microbial control is desired, doses of 3.6 to 7.2 fluid ounces of ALPHA 550 per 1000 gallons of water in the system should be used every three days or as needed. Apply at a constant rate so that the product will be uniformly mixed.
