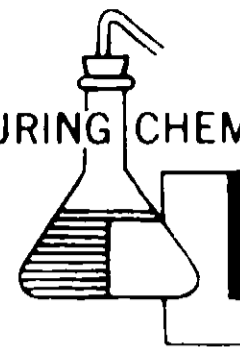

DIRECTIONS: FOR NORMAL CLEANING DILUTE 1 OUNCE OF PRODUCT PER GALLON OF WATER. FOR DISINFECTING, 2 OUNCES PER GALLON MUST BE USED. THIS PRODUCT IS DESIGNED FOR HOSPITAL USE.

PHENOLIC DETERGENT DISINFECTANT NO. 501 CAN BE USED TO CLEAN FLOORS, WALLS, WOODWORK, SINKS AND OTHER SIMILAR HARD SURFACES AND IS TO BE APPLIED BY WIPING, MOPPING, OR SCRUBBING TO WET SURFACES THOROUGHLY WITH THE RECOMMENDED USE DILUTION.

DANGER: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. CORROSIVE. CAUSES EYE DAMAGE AND SKIN IRRITATION. DO NOT GET IN EYES, ON SKIN, OR ON CLOTHING. PROTECT EYES AND SKIN WHEN HANDLING. HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED. AVOID CONTAMINATION OF FOOD.

FIRST AID: IN CASE OF CONTACT, IMMEDIATELY FLUSH EYES OR SKIN WITH PLENTY OF WATER FOR AT LEAST 15 MINUTES. FOR EYES, CALL A PHYSICIAN. REMOVE AND WASH CONTAMINATED CLOTHING BEFORE REUSE. IF SWALLOWED, DRINK PROMPTLY A LARGE QUANTITY OF MILK, EGG WHITES, GELATIN SOLUTION OR IF THESE ARE NOT AVAILABLE, DRINK LARGE QUANTITIES OF WATER. CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.

RINSE EMPTY CONTAINER THOROUGHLY WITH WATER AND DISCARD.
