**KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN**

**DANGER**

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: SKIN AND EYES** In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. **INGESTION** If swallowed, drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or, if these are not available, large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

### DIRECTIONS

#### Dairy, Food, Meat Packing Plant Equipment Sanitizing

Clean and rinse equipment thoroughly. Then rinse with a solution of one  
ounce of CD-630 to four gallons of water (200 ppm of active ingredient). Allow  
at least 2 minutes of contact time; drain and air dry. For cutting boards, use  
a one ounce per gallon solution but be sure to rinse with a 200 ppm CD-630  
solution just before use.

#### Mold Control on Walls and Ceilings in Food Plants

Clean surfaces thoroughly, rinse, then spray with a solution containing one  
ounce of CD-630 to one gallon of water. Repeat treatment periodically particu-  
larly upon reappearance of the mold growth.

#### Sanitization of Glassware, Silverware, Dishes

Clean and rinse thoroughly, then immerse in a solution containing one ounce  
of CD-630 to four gallons of water, drain and air dry. Follow the recommen-  
dations of your health department.

CD-630 Quaternary Ammonium Compound when used as directed fulfills the  
criteria of Appendix F of the Grade "A" Pasteurized Milk Ordinance 1965 Re-  
commendations of the U. S. Public Health Service in waters up to 550 ppm  
(32 grains per gallon) of hardness as CaCO<sub>3</sub>.

\*The State of Wisconsin requires at least a 2 minute exposure to the sanitizing solution.  
Some other states have similar requirements. Check with your local health authority

NOTE: Do not mix with soap or anionic detergents.


