ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Pyrethrins	1.00
*Piperonyl butoxide, technical	1.00
n-octyl bicyclohexene dicarboximide	1.00
Petroleum distillate	1.75

NET INGREDIENTS:

DIRECTIONS

SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

Indoors: To kill flies, mosquitoes, gnats, wasps and flying ants: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow, sweeping motion. Spray 5 - 10 seconds for average room. Keep nozzle 3 feet from surfaces. Keep room closed for 10 minutes after spraying. Before spraying cover exposed food and utensils.

In and around: water ants, silverfish, termites and ants: spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas, and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places, hitting the insects directly. Spray ant hills and ant trails over window and door sills and other locations.

For house plants: spray in short bursts, holding the can 10 inches from foliage for such plants as orchids, ivy and African violets. Spray both sides of the leaves lightly. Do not wet. Repeat as often as necessary. Kills Aphids, plant lice, spider mites, exposed thrips, lace bugs and certain other insects.

Outdoors: For use on such plants as Asters, azaleas, begonias, chrysanthemums, callias, columbinas, gladioli, Irises, Marigolds, Petunias, Roses and Snapdragons. Also for use on evergreens and Small ornamental deciduous Trees, Shrubs and Vines.

When sprayed directly on insects they spray flies sucking insects such as Aphids, leafhoppers, spotted mites, thrips (exposed) and lace bugs. Kills chewing insects such as caterpillars, boxelder leaf beetles, Colorado potato worms and Japanese beetles when sprayed directly.

For best results spray in evening or on a cloudy day when there is little wind. Use slow sweeping motion. Keep can 10 inches from plants. Avoid wetting foliage with the spray. Spray rows at the rate of one foot per second. For heavy growth spray row on both sides. Repeat when needed. Spray with caution on young plants and new growth. Do not spray when temperature exceeds 90° F.

CAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Store upright in a cool place (not over 100° F.). Do not place on hot surface. Do not puncture the can. Never throw in fire or incinerator. May stain finished surfaces if sprayed too closely.
