## **DIRECTIONS**

IMPORTANT After opening and preparing burrow or runway, place fusicin hole in end of cartridge and light. Hold cartridge with fuse end away from you, wait until ingredients become ignited, and place cartridge as directed below. Cover opening in which cartridge is placed with a wet sack, board, stone, or earth to prevent loss of gas, taking care not to cover or obstruct cartridge. If cartridge does not ignite from fuse—hold flame to end until ignited.

CLOSED, RIDGED, SUB-SURFACE RUNWAYS (Moles, Gophers) — At numerous points about the premises, crush-in the ridged, sub-surface runway of the mole with the



side or heef of the foot. The next day, at those points where the mole has reconstructed the runway, open and insert one or more cartridges and cover. Place other cartridges at points 10 to 15 feet distant in the same maze of subsurface tunnels.

OPEN BURROWS (Ground Squirrels) — Place lighted cartridge, lighted end first, deep into each multiple opening. Cover this opening and any other place where gas escapes.



RATS Place ignited Destroyers in all main holes. <u>Close</u> nearby openings from which large amounts of gas are escaping and insert additional cartridges in any other holes which may exist. Repeat treatment as necessary, using two or more cartridges per burrow, to make sure all under ground passages are filled by a sufficient concentration of the gases.

CLOSED DEEP RUNWAYS
(Moles, Pocket Gophers)
— Dig away any loose dirt,
freshly mounded on the
surface by rodents. Examine opened burrow. Light
and quickly place one car-



tridge, lighted end first, in each tunnel observed. Cover and repeat at other focations.

LARGER ANIMALS (Skunk) — Find both entrance and exit to burrow. Seal exit tightly. Ignite cartridge as stated above. Place one or more, as needed, into entrance. Immediately, place covering material over entrance. User may tie three or four cartridges together if more than one cartridge is used. Light all fuses at once, thus giving a larger concentration of gases.
