

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
 Aqua San-Det has been designed specifically for hospitals, nursing homes, schools, restaurants, food processing plants and other institutions where housekeeping is of prime importance.
DISINFECTION-To disinfect hard inanimate surfaces (such as walls, floors, table tops) add 2 ounces San-Det per gallon of water. Apply solution with mop, cloth or sponge or mechanical sprayer so as to wet thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes and then let air dry.
 To disinfect toilet bowls, flush toilet, add 2 ounces San-Det directly to the bowl water. Scab the bowl completely using a scrub brush or toilet mop, making sure to get under the rim. Let stand for 10 minutes and flush.
 For heavily soiled surfaces a pre-cleaning step is required and recommended. Prepare a solution for each use.
SANITIZING-Sanitize previously cleaned and rinsed non-porous surfaces. Prepare 200 ppm active San-Det quaternary solution by adding 2 ounces San-Det to 3 1/2 gallons of water.
 To sanitize immobile items (such as tanks, chopping blocks, counter tops) flood the area with 200 ppm solution or apply with a cloth or sponge, making sure to wet all surfaces completely for at least 60 seconds. Remove and Rinse thoroughly with POTABLE WATER. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.
 To sanitize mobile items (such as drinking glasses, eating utensils) immerse in 200 ppm San-Det solution for at least 60 seconds, making sure to immerse completely. Remove and Rinse thoroughly with POTABLE WATER. Prepare a fresh solution daily or more frequently as soiled as apparent.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a Physician.

For larger areas such as operating rooms, patient care facilities and restrooms, the product is designed to provide both general cleaning and disinfecting. In addition, San-Det deodorizes those areas which are generally hard to keep free of smell, such as garbage storage areas, empty garbage bins and cans, and other areas which are prone to odors caused by microorganisms.


