ANTIDOTE Call physician immediately. If poison

 warm salt solution, ground mustard (1 teaspoonful in a glass of
 warm water) or syrup of ipecac (same amount in water). **HOW-
 EVER, NEVER TRY TO MAKE AN UNCONSCIOUS PERSON
 VOMIT.** After the stomach has been emptied, give a demulcant,
 such as raw eggs, milk, or a thin flour paste. Do not give oil.
 If the poison has been spilled on the skin, or clothing, remove
 clothing and scrub skin thoroughly with soap and warm water.
