PURPOSE	AMOUNT TO USE	DIRECTIONS
LAUNDERING: For washing machines, to whitening clothes. Reduces scorching of white cotton fabrics. If clothes are stained, add 1/2 cup of Bleach to each quart of water. (Will not harm septic tank or machine.)	1 oz. or 1/8 cup of Bleach to each 2 gallons of water, or 1 cup per wash in machine load of 16 garments. For slightly soiled clothes use proportionately less Bleach.	Add Bleach to suds or first rinse. Rinse well if Bleach cannot be added before clothes are in machine. Dilute recommended amount in one quart of water before using.
TO WHITEN YELLOWED OR GREYED NYLON, DACRON, OR ORLON.	Use 2 tablespoons or 1/8 cup Bleach to one gallon fair, warm water.	Immerse in warm water 15-30 minutes. Bleach solution may be diluted.
REMOVE SCORCH & STAINS: Such as fruit, ink, berry, wine, coffee, tea, chocolate, grease, etc. Also "dew"	Five parts Bleach to 20 parts water, or 1/4 cup Bleach per quart of water.	Soak fabric 5 to 10 minutes in Bleach solution. Rinse well.
CLEANING KITCHEN & BATHROOM: Bleach is excellent for cleaning tile, porcelain, enamelware, bathtubs & fixtures.	3 tablespoons or 1/8 cup Bleach in quart of cold water.	Spread with cloth moistened with cold water. Let stand 2 minutes. Rinse well.
SPECIAL DISINFECTING USES: For Restaurants, Taverns, Soda Fountains, etc.	1 oz. or 1/8 cup of Bleach per 2 gallons of water.	This is a recommended standard disinfecting solution by many Public Health Departments. MAKES SOLUTION 200 PPM AVAILABLE CHLORINE.
GENERAL DISINFECTING USES: Dish cloths, handkerchiefs, diapers, baby clothes, etc.	3 tablespoons of Bleach to each quart of 40°C or warmer water.	First wash in clear water. Immerse in Bleach solution 5 minutes. Rinse well.
SWIMMING POOLS: To make the water hygienically secure. Add 1 oz. per 10,000 gallons of new water. Test water frequently and add Bleach as required to maintain 0.6 to 0.8 PPM Available Chlorine.	28 oz. 3 1/2 cups Bleach to each 10,000 gallons of new water. Test water frequently and add Bleach as required to maintain 0.6 to 0.8 PPM Available Chlorine.	Thoroughly mix Bleach in 20 parts water and feed solution through a chlorinator or dilute and scatter over surface of pool.
SICKROOM, URINALS, BEDPANS, SPUTUM CUPS, ETC. To clean.	3 tablespoons of Bleach per quart of hot water.	Wash clean. Place in Bleach solution 5 minutes. Rinse.
TOILET BOWLS, DRAIN PIPES (Clean)	Full strength. For stains 1/2 cup in toilet bowl and a few drops of vine-gar or lemon will remove stains.	Will not harm plumbing or septic tanks. Do not use with other household chemicals. Flush with boiling water.



