BERMUDAGRASS CONTROL

WHERE TO APPLY: Apply anywhere — in tree wells, driveways, sidewalks, in and around bushes and shrubs and right in broadleaf ground cover — wherever unwanted bermuda exists. This herbicide will attack and destroy the root structure of Bermudagrass but will not harm desired plants. When destroying Bermuda patches in grass lawns such as St. Augustine or Kentucky Blue, this material will destroy the immediately adjacent lawn also and treated spots will remain bare for one growing season. However replanting may be done the following year.

HOW TO APPLY: Use gloves when handling. Uniformly sprinkle contents of one packet throughout an area of 50 sq. ft. (5' x 10'). Do not overtreat. If possible, scratch into the soil with light raking. Water into soil with hand sprinkling. Do not allow water to run or puddle, especially around the trunks of ornamentals. Apply directly to soil. Remove redwood chips, etc., if present, before application. Destroy any surface growth by spraying CONTROL RAPID KILL #1. In areas where the grass is intermingled with ground cover and contact killing is impossible, hand-pull the grass that extends above the

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plantings. Lack of direct sunlight on the grass will greatly help in establishing control.

WHEN TO APPLY: A control program can be started anytime during the growing season. Usually two or three treatments approximately six weeks apart will give good control.

TYPE OF CONTROL: In areas where the Bermuda is intermingled with ground cover, BERMUDAGRASS ROOT KILLER will stunt the grass, prevent its growth and gradually turn it brown while not damaging the broadleaf ground cover. In other areas use CONTROL RAPID KILL #1 to brown out surface growth wherever possible, and good control will be quickly established. The combined effect of destroying the surface growth as well as the roots will eradicate this pest.

NUT GRASS CONTROL

WHERE TO APPLY: Apply in all areas where Nut Grass appears except in desired grass lawn areas. Follow directions as shown for Bermudagrass Control.

COVERAGE: Approximately 200 sq. ft. Contents of each bag will cover 50 square feet.
