## **DIRECTIONS**

Use a plastic or plastic lined sprayer. Do not allow LARVEX to drip from the outside metal of the sprayer onto material being treated. Be sure to rinse sprayer with water after use.

Before using LARVEX be sure articles are clean and free from spots.

**CLOTHING:** Spray LARVEX freely on all woolen surfaces until thoroughly moist. Avoid spraying linings or any fabrics likely to become water-marked. Unlined articles should be sprayed inside and out. Be sure to spray all folds and seams

NOTE: LARVEX IS COMPLETELY ODORLESS AND SO ARTICLES CAN BE WORN IMMEDIATELY AFTER TREATMENT. Simply allow treated material to dry thoroughly. Storage is not necessary for effective mothproofing with LARVEX!

FURNITURE: Remove cushions and cover linings. After rubbing woodwork with furniture oil, spray by letting mist settle lightly on upholstery until thoroughly damp. Never touch mohair while it is wet.

CARPETS AND RUGS: Spray both sides of wool backed rugs but spray only the face of jute or glue backed rugs.

NEVER USE LARVEX ON FURS
