## **DIRECTIONS**

The U. S. Dept. of Public Health recommends chlorine residual of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm for swimming pools.

To establish a chlorine residual of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm add 2 oz. of POOL DOCTOR DRY CHLORINE per 10,000 gallons of water. Repeat dosage until 1.0 ppm residual chlorine is obtained. Thereafter add more product daily, or as needed to maintain 0.6 to 1.0 residual chlorine. Test pool water frequently with chlorine test kit. A schedule of daily treatments and regular testing will result in an attractive pool.

For best chlorine stability the pH range should be maintained from 7.2 to 7.6. Use a POOL DOCTOR CHLORINE AND PH TEST KIT daily.
