USE A TEST KIT AND INCREASE DOSAGE AS NECESSARY TO OBTAIN THE REQUIRED LEVEL OF AVAILABLE CHLORINE. MAINTAIN WATER pH AT 7.2-7.6 AS DETERMINED WITH SUITABLE TEST KIT**
