DANGER KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID): If swallowed, feed bread soaked in milk followed by olive oil or cooking oil. Call a physician immediately.

IF ON SKIN: Brush off excess chemical and flush skin with cold water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its label.

1. CHECK RESIDUAL CHLORINE with a Pool Doctor Chlorine Test Kit. If residual chlorine is less than 1.0 ppm, add 10 ounces Pool Doctor Dry Chlor per 10,000 gallons of water. Broadcast 10 ounces Pool Doctor Dry Chlor to water by broadcasting over pool surface and in the evening. An alternate method of addition is to add 10 ounces Pool Doctor Dry Chlor to 10 gallons of water, allow to settle, and pour clear solution into pool. An alternate method of addition is to add 10 ounces Pool Doctor Dry Chlor to 10 gallons of water, allow to settle, and pour clear solution into pool.

2. MAINTAIN RESIDUAL CHLORINE. If pool is not stabilized, add 10 ounces Pool Doctor Dry Chlor per 10,000 gallons every day. If the pool is stabilized add 2-3 ounces every other day or as needed to maintain 1.0-1.5 ppm residual chlorine. 10 ounces of this product supply 1.0 ppm chlorine. Additional dosage may be required during exceptionally hot weather. If people are using the pool, **STABILIZE** pool with Pool Doctor Stabilizer (Pool Doctor Dry Acid)*

3. Pool Doctor Dry Chlor is also a strong algacide. To prevent algae blooms use 12-15 ounces of Pool Doctor Dry Chlor per 10,000 gallons of water. Remove settled algae and debris with Pool Doctor Algae Remover. Run the pump for 12 hours. Check the water, if needed, and adjust accordingly.

4. SUPERCHLORINATION is necessary after a heavy rain. Superchlorinate approximately every 7-14 days when water temperature is above 60°F. Superchlorinate by adding 5 oz. product per 5,000 gallons of water.

5. MEASURE pH at least once each week with a Pool Doctor pH Test Kit. Adjust pH to 7.2-7.8 if necessary by adding Pool Doctor Dry Acid* to reduce pH, or Pool Doctor Soda Ash* to increase pH.
