Suhm NO-ALG is a recirculatory water cooling tower Algaecide used to control algae and eliminate the annoying and expensive problems associated with it.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

INITIAL DOSE: The initial treatment must be applied to a manually cleaned system or when algae are first visible in the system.

In a manually cleaned system with no algae visible, add 0.6 gallons (2.4 quarts) of NO-ALG per 1,000 gallons of cooling water in the system to obtain an active ingredient concentration of 30 parts per million.

In a system where algae is first visible, add 1.2 gallons (4.8 quarts) of NO-ALG per 1,000 gallons of cooling water in the system to obtain an active ingredient concentration of 60 parts per million.

SUBSEQUENT TREATMENT: After the initial dose, add 0.3 to 0.6 gallons of NO-ALG per 1,000 gallons of cooling water in the system once per week, or more often if needed, to prevent algae. If growth becomes visible, a "slug dose" of 0.6 to 1.2 gallons of NO-ALG per 1,000 gallons of cooling water in the system should be added. This slug dose should then be followed by the regular maintenance dose. Slug additions should be made in the sump of water cooling towers.
