The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Revise the "Directions" heading to read "Directions for Use."
2. Delete the signal word "Caution" from the left side panel. The appropriate signal word for this label is "Warning."
3. Place the statement "Keep Out Of Reach of Children" above the signal word "Warning."
4. Delete Tetrasodium ethylenediamine, tetraacetate, sodium metasilicate, and essential oils from the active ingredients list. They must be added to the inerts. Adjust the percentages accordingly.


