Use 1 ounce of ICS in 5 gallons of warm water. (Provides 25 PPM titratable iodine) Brush all surfaces thoroughly, rinse with clear water and drain.

### BULK TANKS COMMENTS

Use 1 ounce of ICS in 2 1/2 gallons of warm water. (Provides 50 PPM titratable iodine) Brush all surfaces thoroughly, rinse with clear water and drain.
