

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of a federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. ALPHA SAN 300 is recommended for use on hard (non-porous) surfaces, on dishes, glasses or food processing equipment or utensils, including dairy and brewery equipment and utensils. Prepare sanitizing solution by dissolving 1 oz. of ALPHA SAN 300 per 10 gal. water. This gives a solution containing 100 ppm available chlorine. Clean and rinse item or surface prior to sanitizing. Then place dishes, glasses, equipment or utensils in the solution or spread it over the surface to be sanitized. Let stand 2 to 5 minutes and allow to air dry. The same solution may be used in the feed tank in immersion or spray type machines providing 2 to 5 minutes of contact time for sanitizing dishes, glasses, food processing equipment and utensils. Clean and rinse items prior to sanitizing. Do not rinse after sanitizing.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE:

Store in original container. Store in cool dry area away from direct sunlight or heat. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage or disposal.

DISPOSAL:

Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
