

Attachment A - Batch 3 Products

Labeling:

1. The signal word is "Danger".

2. The Precautionary Statements should read:

"Corrosive: Cause irreversible eye damage. May be fatal if inhaled. Causes skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not breathe dust. Wear goggles or face shield. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse".

3. The Statements of Practical Treatment should read:

If Swallowed: Drink promptly large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician or Poison Control Center.

If on Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably, mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

If in Eyes: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

Note to Physician: Probably mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

**STORE IN COOL DRY PLACE
KEEP CONTAINER CLOSED**

Alpha San 200 is an organic chlorine agent for sanitizing dairy, food and beverage equipment. To obtain proper use dilution strengths, do not store Alpha San 200 over 12 months from date of manufacture.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

All equipment should be thoroughly cleaned and rinsed prior to using Alpha San 200 as a sanitizer. Prepare a 100 ppm sanitizing solution by dissolving 1/2 oz. Alpha San 200 in 5 gallons of water. Place glasses, dishes, equipment or utensils in the solution or spread it over the surface to be sanitized, allowing a contact time of atleast one minute. Allow to air dry. Do not rinse with potable water before reuse. Prepare a fresh solution daily or more frequently as soil is apparent.
