DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal labeling laws if the labeling on ALPHA SAN 300 is removed. Do not use on dishes, glasses or food service machines) and do not use on pumps. Prepare a sanitizing solution by adding 1/4 oz. of water. This gives a solution of 2 to 5 minutes and allow in immersion type machines, dishes, glasses, food prior to sanitizing. Do not use on Dairy Equipment (soft water). Add 1/4 oz. Alpha San 300 to the water. Pump into freezer and Sanitize before using by 2.5 gallons of water (100°F).

WISCONSIN DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- Scrape and pre-wash.
- Wash with a good detergent.
- Rinse with potable water.
- Sanitize in a solution of 2.5 gallons water (100°F) for at least two minutes.
- Place sanitized utensils in a clean container.

NOTE: A clean potable water supply is required. See Section HFS 196.13 of the Wisconsin Code.

STORAGE

STORAGE:
Store in original container, away from direct sunlight or heat. Do not store in large quantities of water. Do not store in storage or disposal containers.
