ON ANIMALS: To protect, attle and horses from horn flies, house flies, mosquitoes and gnats, apply a light mist sufficient to well the surface of the hair. To control stable flies, horse flies and deer flies, apply at a rate of 2 ounces per adult cow or horse, sufficient to well the hair thoroughly. Repeat treatment daily or at intervals necessary to give continued protection.
