#### DANGER

Use quantity of undiluted Vapo-Steril sufficient to fill reservoir tank. Refer to operating instructions accompanying each Harvey Chemiclave.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**PROHIBITIONS:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Store in an upright position in a cool, dry location. Do not reuse Vapo-Steril.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse container. Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and disposal of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
