The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with the Label Improvement Program Notice for Antimicrobial Products Used as Food Contact Surface Sanitizers, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling change listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - Under the food contact surface sanitizer claims, expand the directions to include the following:
 - a. The necessity for removal of gross food particles and soil by a preflush, or prescrape and, when necessary, presoak treatment. In addition, instructions must be provided for a thorough washing of surfaces or objects with a good detergent or compatible cleaner, followed by a potable water rinse before application of the sanitizing solution.
 - b. The method of application (e.g., immersion, flooding, spraying) to wet all surfaces thoroughly.
 - c. The contact time of at least 1 minute required for sanitization. The directions must also provide instructions to drain the use solution from the surface and air dry.
 - d. Delete the statement ONLY FOR SALE TO, USE, AND STORAGE BY SERVICE PERSONS.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

COLD DISINFECTION

For disinfection of previously cleaned surgical instruments, barber tools and dental equipment, simply submerge instruments into solution containing 1½ ounces per gallon of water for 10 minutes.

RESTAURANT AND BAR RINSE

Dishes, glassware, silverware, cooking utensils, wash with soap or synthetic detergent, rinse thoroughly, and immerse in a sanitizing solution containing 1 ounce to 4 gallons of water. No Terminal Potable Water Rinse Required.

FOR ROOM FOGGING

DIRECTIONS: To minimize the danger of crosscontamination from environmental surfaces apply solution of product as a fog as described below, before applying standard routine terminal cleaning and disinfecting practices. 1. Remove all human, animal and plant life from room. 2. Open closet doors and drawers. 3. Set up 34" revolving platform in center of room. 4. Mount Jet FOGMASTER TRIJET MODEL 8208, or other fogging device delivering equivalent spray at 3 RPM. 5. Fill sprayer reservoir with 1.5 oz. of product to 1 gallon of water to produce 1,150 ppm active ingredients. 6. Set sprayer mechanism to deliver 1 gallon of solution. 7. Fog for 15 minutes for an average 2100 cu. ft. room. For different room size, vary spray time proportionately to ensure complete wetting of exposed surfaces. 8. Wait 2 hours before entering room after treatment. 9. Rinse fogging equipment thoroughly with clear water following use.

HOUSEHOLD: For sanitizing and disinfecting floors, walls and inanimate hard surfaces. For schools, homes, locker rooms, garbage
