DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use this ornamental plant insecticide to control the above listed insects on flowers, shrubs, vines, shade and flowering trees and evergreens found to be infected with these pests. Dilute this ornamental plant insecticide with water according to directions given in the following table and apply using a suitable low pressure sprayer such as a knapsack type or hose-attached applicator in a manner to provide complete and uniform coverage of infested plants. Avoid over-spraying to the point of excessive runoff. Treat when pests appear and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals if needed.

NOTE: Do not use on azaleas, camelias, poinsettias, rose bushes or variegated ivy because of possible injury to these plants
