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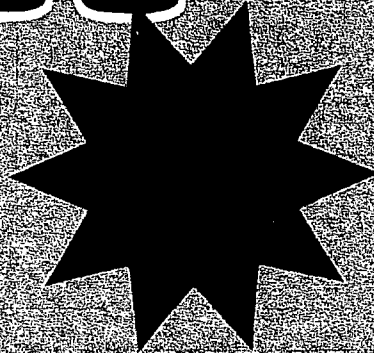
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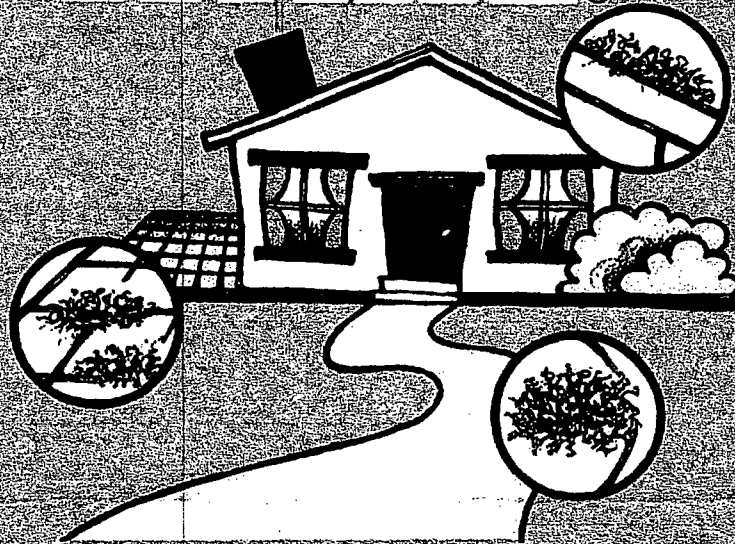

Destroying and preventing moss can extend the life of roofs, and improve the condition of patios and walkways. **MOSS-B-WARE®** won't stain roofs or corrode aluminum and galvanized gutters, when used as directed. And if applied from this shaker container, no other equipment is necessary.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WHEN TO MOSS-B-WARE®

MOSS-B-WARE® can be used any time of the year as an effective moss killer and preventative. For best results, apply during rainy seasons - this is when moss grows most rapidly. You should see the dying moss changing color within 3 to 4 weeks. Light to average moss growth on pitched roofs should slowly wash away with the rain. If the growth is heavy or on flat areas, you may need to physically remove the dead moss.

HOW TO MOSS-B-WARE®

You can shake it on directly or dissolve in water. Just use the method below that best suits your needs.

Do not allow spray or dust to drift from the application site and contact people, nontarget structures people occupy at any time and associated property, parks and recreation areas, nontarget crops, aquatic and wetland areas, woodlands, pastures, rangelands, or animals. Apply only when wind speed is not more than 10 mph. For sprays, apply largest droplets possible.

TO KILL EXISTING MOSS ...

Pitched roofs that can be walked upon, such as composition, wood shingles, or shakes can most easily be treated by shaking **MOSS-B-WARE®** directly from the container along the ridge of the roof. Rains can then wash **MOSS-B-WARE®** down through lower moss patches. Apply 3 lbs. for 600 square feet of treatment area.

Rock, gravel, flat roofs and roofs that cannot be walked upon should be treated with a liquid application, using a sprinkling can or any type of pump-up sprayer. Slowly add contents of this container to 5 to 10 gallons of water, stirring until completely dissolved. Single mixture will cover 600 square feet of roofing and will usually control moss for two years.

Patios and walkways are most effectively treated with sprinkling can or pump-up sprayer application. Dead moss can just be swept away. Mix contents of this container in 5 gallons of water and apply to 600 square feet of area. Annual applications may be necessary.

TO PREVENT MOSS GROWTH ...

Use **MOSS-B-WARE®** to stop moss before it starts. Just follow the directions for killing existing moss. For prevention only, use at a rate of one pound per 1,000 square feet. This may require annual reapplication.

Para obtener mejores resultados, aplique durante la época de lluvia que es cuando el musgo crece con mayor rapidez. Usted se enterará por el cambio de color de 3 a 4 semanas después. El crecimiento de leve a moderado de musgo sobre los techos inclinados se debería lavar con la lluvia. Si el crecimiento es severo en las áreas planas, puede ser que necesite retirar físicamente el musgo muerto.

COMO APLICAR MOSS-B-WARE®

Usted puede aplicarlo directamente o disolverlo en agua. Sólo use el método a continuación que se acomodó mejor a sus necesidades.

No permita que la pulverización o el polvo se desplace fuera del lugar de aplicación y haga contacto con personas, estructuras que no son objetivo y que pueden ser ocupadas por personas en cualquier momento y propiedades asociadas, parques y áreas de recreación, cultivos que no son objetivo, áreas acústicas y pantanosas, hosques, pastos o animales. Los techos inclinados sobre los que se puede caminar, como en una composición, entramados o duelas de madera, se pueden tratar más fácilmente agitando **MOSS-B-WARE®** directamente desde el envase a lo largo del caballete techo. Luego, la lluvia puede lavar el **MOSS-B-WARE®** hacia los parches de musgo que se encuentran más abajo. Aplique 3 libras (1.36 kg) para 600 pies cuadrados (55.74 metros cuadrados) de área a tratar.

Rocas, grava, techos planos y techos sobre los que no se puede caminar, se deben tratar con aplicación líquida utilizando un bote rociador o cualquier tipo de pulverizador de bomba. Lentamente añada el contenido de este envase en 5 a 10 galones (19 a 38 litros) de agua, agitando hasta que esté completamente disuelto. Una sola mezcla cubrirá 600 pies cuadrados (55.74 metros cuadrados) de techos y usualmente controlará el musgo por dos años.

Los patios y los corredores se pueden tratar más efectivamente con un bote rociador o con un pulverizador de bomba. El musgo muerto se puede barrer. Mezcle el contenido de este envase en 5 galones (19 litros) de agua y aplíquelo a 600 pies cuadrados (55.74 metros cuadrados) de área. Pueden ser necesarias aplicaciones anuales.
