NOTE: This product degrades rapidly. Obtain the required level of chlorine as soon as possible.

For a new pool or spring start with 5 to 10 ppm. Adjust and maintain pool chlorine to between 50 to 100 ppm.

To maintain the pool, add 1 oz. of water to yield an available chlorine residual of 1.0 ppm. At the end of the swimming season, test the water temperature and number of swimmers. Every seven (7) days, or at 10,000 gallons of water to chlorine with a test kit. Do not allow to dissipate from the pool prior to discharge.

WINTERIZING POOLS—When filter is running, obtain a pool, prepare heater/filter.

DISINFECTION
Mix a ratio of 1 oz. of this product until a free available chlorine the distribution system. Check conducted at a frequency of 1 Regulation. Contact your local health department.

SANITIZING
Before application of this sanitizer, followed by a potability test. Thoroughly mix 1 oz. sanitizing solution, maintain the surface and air dry. Do overnight. For automated cleaning more often if the solution is used for general cleaning.

STORAGE AND
