The following requirements or revisions apply to the label which was accepted with this registration notice:

(1) The registration number which has been assigned to this product must appear on the label as EPA Reg. No. 10707-22.

(2) Revise the precautionary statements as follows:

Causes severe eye irritation. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield when handling. Remove and wash contaminated clothing. Irritating to nose and throat. Do not breathe fumes. Avoid contamination of food.

(3) Revise the pesticide disposal section as follows:

Wastes resulting from the used of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

(4) Delete "or bury in a safe place" from the container disposal section.

(5) The labels which will be used for this product in channels of trade must reflect these revisions.

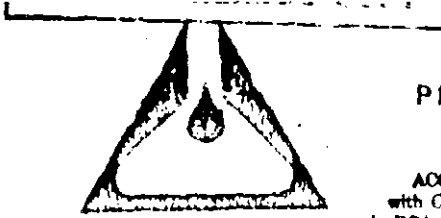

This pesticide is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not apply in marine and/or estuarine oil fields. STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

FIRST AID:

In case of contact with eyes or skin, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Call a physician. If swallowed give large amounts of water. Call a physician.

CHEMICAL HAZARDS:

Magnacide C-1 is a strong oxidizing agent. Mix only with water. Do not contaminate with organic or inorganic material. Organic or inorganic contamination may cause a chemical reaction with the liberation of heat, poisonous gases, and possible fire and explosion.

STORAGE AND HANDLING:

Keep container closed when not in use. Do not reuse empty container. Store in a cool, dry, ventilated area, away from heat, sparks, and open flames.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

1. Prohibitions - Do not contaminate water, food, or feed. Open dumping is prohibited.
2. Pesticide Disposal - Pesticide, spray mixture, or residue or chemically processed should be disposed of in a landfill or buried in a safe place away from water supply.
3. Container Disposal - (a) Recycle container and offer for recycling. (b) Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling or disposal in approved landfill, or bury in a safe place.
4. General - Consult Federal, State or Local disposal authority for alternative procedures.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this material in a manner inconsistent with its label. This material should only be applied in accordance with the label. This material should only be applied in accordance with EPA Bulletin C-2, under the supervision of trained personnel.

Continuous Treatment - Excellent control of microorganisms secured with Magnacide C-2 by continuous treatment with 10 ppm or less chlorine dioxide. The specific rates depend on the type and prevalence of organisms present. Treatment usually 10 ppm as chlorine dioxide. After the system is cleaned, dosage can often be gradually lowered depending on the results of the problem.

Batch Treatment - Magnacide C-2 can also be applied in batch treatment to maintain a clean and trouble free system. The frequency of batch treatment depends on the type of system and the rate of growth of particular bacteria.

The level for initial treatments is a concentration of 10 ppm chlorine dioxide for a duration of 3-6 hours. Intervals between treatments from 1 to 7 days, depending on the cleanliness of the system of the problem. After the system is cleaned, treatment frequency reduced. This is accomplished by adjusting application rate or the amount of Magnacide C-2 used.
