

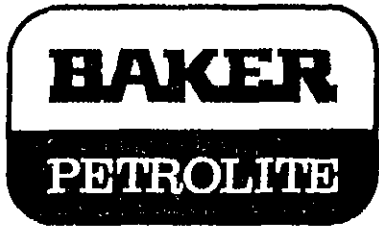

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

OIL FIELD WATER FLOOD OR SALT WATER DISPOSAL SYSTEMS:  
(Do not apply in Marine and Estuarine Oil Fields)

1. For the control of slime forming and sulfate reducing bacteria in oilfield water flood or salt water disposal systems, add Magnacide G113 Industrial Microbiocide (.3 gallons per 100 barrels of water) continuously. Levels for effective control will vary depending on conditions at the site.
2. For intermittent use, dose at a rate of 720 ppm Magnacide G113 Industrial Microbiocide (3 gallons per 100 barrels of water) for 4-8 hours per day, one to four times a week as needed to maintain control

Add Magnacide G113 Industrial Microbiocide directly from the drum with the proper type of metering equipment. This product weighs 7.43 lbs/gallon (at 20°C).
